## COMPLAINT



The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Camden, State of Missouri, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.034, RSMo, committed the class C felony of statutory rape in the second degree, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about October 1, 2010, in the County of Camden, State of Missouri, the defendant had sexual intercourse with [REDACTED] and at that time [REDACTED] was less than seventeen years old and the defendant was twenty-one years of age or older.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement of facts, made a part hereof and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant or a summons be issued as provided by law.

RANGE OF PUNISHMENT

The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or if money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, a fine of not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine.

## PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT FORM

I John Pehle, an investigator with the Missouri State Technical Assistance Team, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on or about October 2010, at 231 Chimney Rock Rd Camdenton Camden County, Missouri, Jenner B. Shaffer M/W DOB 03-21-1972 SSN [REDACTED] committed the following criminal offenses:

Statutory Rape 2<sup>nd</sup> 4 counts.

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 22 August 2012 I was contacted by Miller County Detective Tammy Moore who requested assistance from STAT with a child sexual abuse investigation. Det. Moore advised that on 20 August 2012 she had been interviewing a 17 year old female [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]) in reference to a separate investigation. [REDACTED] mother who was also present mentioned that [REDACTED] one year old son was fathered by one of [REDACTED] previous teachers, a 40 year male named Jenner Shaffer (DOB 3-21-72).


On 23 August 2012 Det. Moore contacted me and advised that [REDACTED] had been interviewed at the Kid's Harbor Child Advocacy Center (CAC) and spoke about Jenner Schaffer having sex with her while she was a high school student and he was her English teacher. [REDACTED] stated that her son [REDACTED] father is Jenner Shaffer. [REDACTED] stated that she met Shaffer at school and he gave her his phone number to text him to help her with her poetry and she later went to his home because he had told her he published books. [REDACTED] stated that she went over to Shaffer house several times and while at his house they had sex on more than one occasion, which she believed was 4 times. [REDACTED] stated she conceived [REDACTED] from that sexual relationship with Jenner Shaffer. [REDACTED] stated that Jenner Shaffer helped her with some of the medical expenses of the pregnancies and took her to her doctor appointments. [REDACTED] stated that she kept the fact that Jenner Shaffer was the father of [REDACTED] secret because she did not want him to get in trouble. [REDACTED] stated that she takes [REDACTED] and leaves him with Jenner Shaffer and his new girlfriend for visitation. Based on [REDACTED] date of birth ([REDACTED]) the incidents of sexual contact between [REDACTED] and Jenner Shaffer occurred in or around October 2010 which [REDACTED] was 15 years old during this time and Jenner Shaffer was 38 years old. Based on [REDACTED] description of the residence and prior history check of Jenner Shaffer I determined Shaffer was living at 231 Chimney Rock Road, Camdenton Missouri which is located in Camden County Missouri during this time period. I contacted Camden County Sheriff's Office and advised them of this report and they requested I continue the investigation.

In conducting a background check I located a past report of Shaffer being accused of inappropriate sexual contact with a student in 2011 in the north Missouri area.

On 29 August 2012 I contacted Jenner Shaffer near his residence in Wheatland, Missouri. I interviewed Shaffer who advised that he believed he was [REDACTED] father. Shaffer stated that he started a relationship with [REDACTED] when she was a freshman and they were boyfriend and girlfriend during the fall of 2010. Shaffer stated that he and [REDACTED] had as sexual relationship during this time. Shaffer also stated that he was living at the Chimney Rock Rd address when this relationship was occurring. Shaffer stated that [REDACTED] later "dumped" him but they had planned to be together after she was not considered a minor any longer.
